

Definitions

#

- Institutional Repository (IR):
 - $\circ\,$ Online, open access platform where LMU can gather, preserve, and share output by its members.
- Open Access (OA):
 - $\,\circ\,$ Work is available to read online by anyone to assist in non-profit research and education.
 - $\,\circ\,$ Work may not be used for commercial purposes without permission from copyright holder.
- Green OA
 - Publication that is made available by depositing a copy into an OA repository (usually free).
 - Sometimes, publishers impose restrictions on which version can be submitted (Published, Accepted, Submitted) and where the version can be submitted (author's website, IR, funder designated location, etc.).
- Gold OA
 - $\,\circ\,$ Publication made OA through publisher (usually requires a fee).
 - $\,\circ\,$ Can often be submitted to OA repositories as well.
- Sherpa Romeo may be consulted for several journal OA policies.



IR for Faculty

- Self-archive peer-reviewed articles:
 - IR manager can help navigate OA policies on Sherpa Romeo.
- Preserve scholarly output not typically published:
 - Presentations,
 - Programs,
 - Research Posters,
 - Teaching material.
- Submission options:
 - Faculty, self-submission or,
 - Librarian, mediated submission (Quick Submit).

- Increases LMU's visibility,
- Increases your department's visibility,
- Increases potential for research to be cited by others,
- Provides faculty with a single location to aggregate and showcase research and publications,
- Readership information (PlumX Metrics, readership reports, DC dashboard),
- Permanent URLs,
- Options available for embargoes and access restriction,
- Work can be found through popular search engines such as Google and Bing.



IR for Students

- Students Research:
 - Capstone Projects,
 - Electronic Theses and Dissertations (ETDs),
 - $\,\circ\,$ Honors Theses,
 - \odot Presentations,
 - Research Posters,
 - Other Research Projects,
- Submission Options:
 - Mediated submission (Quick Submit),
 - $\,\circ\,$ Self submission.
 - All student submissions must be verified by faculty/staff from relevant department.

- Makes research available outside of LMU, including to potential employers and graduate schools,
- Increases potential for research to be cited by others,
- Readership information (PlumX Metrics, readership reports, DC dashboard),
- Permanent URLs,
- Options available for embargoes and access restriction,
- Work can be found through popular search engines such as Google and Bing.

Analytics

- PlumX Metrics:
 - Citations,
 - Social media postings,
 - $\circ\,$ Views,
 - Downloads.
- Digital Commons Dashboard:
 - Downloads,
 - General location of readership (Countries, states, institutions, etc.),
 - Metadata hits (Views),
 - Referrers (e.g. Google),
 - o Monthly report.



Other Services

- Journal Hosting:
 - IR manager available to help faculty create new journals.
 - IR manager available to help with technical issues.
 - Journal can be OA or subscriber based.
 - Student journals must have at least one faculty supervisor.
- Event Hosting





- Mediated Submission:
 - Go to digitalcommons.lmunet.edu;
 - Click Quick Submit link under Author's Corner on the left side bar.
 - Provide name, date, email, document, and agree to terms.



• Self Submission:

- Go to digital commons. Imunet. edu;
- \circ Click the link for My Account;
- Click the link for Sign Up. Fill out the online form and click Create Account;
- Click Collections→Select appropriate School, College, Division, or Event→Select appropriate collection;
- In the lower left corner, click Submit Research;
- Fill out submission agreement;
- Fill out the electronic form and upload your submission. Theses and dissertations should have the signature page on front;
- \circ Submit.


Promoting the IR

Benefits of submitting your research to LMU's IR
How do I submit my work?
I plan to publish my work. Can I still submit?
<u>Access Options</u>
I don't have electronic versions of old working papers that I'd like to include in the repository. Is it okay to scan the printed page to a PDF file?
When I copy and paste abstracts into the Submit form, some formatted text reverts to plain text. What's going on?
How do I include accents and special characters in the abstracts and titles?
How do I revise a submission?
How can I submit a multi-part file, such as multiple chapters for a book?
Can I post related files (sound clips, data sets, etc.) alongside the published article?
Can I post a reprint from a journal?
A working paper in our repository site has been published in a slightly revised form in a journal. What should I do?
